exp.at'19 is the 5th event of the conference series *exp.at'xx*. The conference will be held at the University of Madeira (Funchal, Madeira Island, Portugal) on June 12-14, 2019, and it is a joint organization of University of Porto and University of Coimbra with the collaboration of University of Madeira. The conference will feature the technical support of IEEE (IEEE Industrial Electronics Society and IEEE Education Society) and the Portuguese Engineers Association.

OEEE'19, the Special Track "Online Experimentation in Science and Engineering Education" within *exp.at'19*, will focus on pedagogical usage scenarios of online experimentation, i.e. its use and usefulness; how can technology help to solve pedagogical problems in experimental frameworks?

- Integrating Novel Modes and pedagogical Topics into Lab Work (e.g. Inverted Classroom, Problem-Based Learning, Employability, Sustainability, Creativity, Responsibility, Social Inclusion, etc.)
- Future Capabilities and Constraints of Labs in Engineering Education
